SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR

This is a summary of the annual report of the United Mine Workers of America Prefunded Benefit Plan, EIN 26-1508254, Plan No. 501, for period January 01, 2011 through December 31, 2011. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$8,034,104 as of December 31, 2011, compared to \$7,822,295 as of January 01, 2011. During the plan year the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$211,809. This increase includes unrealized appreciation and depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$345,989, including earnings from investments of \$345,989.

Plan expenses were \$134,180. These expenses included \$87,428 in administrative expenses, \$40,966 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries, and \$5,786 in other expenses.
